

ROYAL COMMISSION into Violence, Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation of People with Disability

The Disability Royal Commission was established in April 2019 in response to community concern about widespread reports of violence against, and the neglect, abuse and exploitation of, people with disability.

The Commission aims to:

- prevent and better protect people with disability
- achieve best practice in reporting, investigating and responding to violence, abuse, neglect and exploitation of people with disability
- promote a more inclusive society to support people with disability to be independent and live free from violence, abuse, neglect and exploitation

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the Commission have suspended all community forums until further notice but they are engaging with stakeholders using on-line technology.
