




Professional development is provided to larger groups at SIES and includes presentations from a range of SIES service providers. The sessions aim to offer consultation, advice and support regarding adjustments for learners with a disability and/or learning difficulty to enable access, engagement, participation and attainment.

Presentations can incorporate brief overviews or more in depth instruction on topics including but not limited to:

-  The identification of Specialised Learning Materials and related implementation strategies, planning and adjustment personalised learning and inclusive intervention strategies
-  identification and/or implementation of appropriate technologies and strategies
-  assistive reading and writing technologies in all platforms (Microsoft, Apple, Google Education) eg Clicker 8, Dragon, ClaroRead, Texthelp, Ghotit,

This service is provided at SIES for whole or half day training or can be negotiated to fit into a staff meeting. The session will include a tour of our Resource Centre and allow time for participants to browse and borrow from the collection.
